CLINICAL FIELD REFERENCE

FOUR POINTS TO UNDERSTAND

HISTORY

DESCRIBE THE LONGITUDINAL PATTERN

Give accurate onset, frequency, duration, treatment, triggers, and changes over time.

ATTACK

EXPLAIN A TYPICAL PROSTRATING ATTACK

Describe symptoms, what becomes impossible, what you do, and how long recovery takes.

WORK

REPORT FUNCTIONAL IMPACT

Discuss missed work, interrupted tasks, driving or safety limits, concentration, and accommodations.

CHECK

REVIEW THE REPORT

Confirm it addresses frequency, prostration, prolonged attacks, economic impact, and the requested nexus theory.

Apply the current regulation and case law to the individual record. Attack frequency, severity, duration, and functional impact should be documented accurately and consistently.
