CLINICAL FIELD REFERENCE

FOUR POINTS TO UNDERSTAND

0%

LESS FREQUENT ATTACKS

Migraine attacks occur less often than the compensable criteria require.

10%

ABOUT ONE IN TWO MONTHS

Characteristic prostrating attacks average one in two months over the last several months.

30%

ABOUT ONCE A MONTH

Characteristic prostrating attacks occur on average once a month over the last several months.

50%

MAXIMUM SCHEDULAR RATING

Very frequent, completely prostrating and prolonged attacks are productive of severe economic inadaptability.

Apply the current regulation and case law to the individual record. Attack frequency, severity, duration, and functional impact should be documented accurately and consistently.
