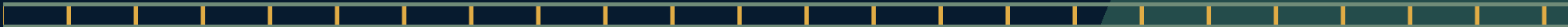

FIELD REFERENCE

FOUR POINTS TO UNDERSTAND

30 DAYS

SERVICE REQUIREMENT

At least 30 cumulative days at Camp Lejeune or MCAS New River from August 1, 1953 through December 31, 1987.

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LISTED DISEASES

Adult leukemia, aplastic anemia and myelodysplastic syndromes, bladder, kidney, and liver cancer, multiple myeloma, non-Hodgkin lymphoma, and Parkinson's disease.

RECORD

DOCUMENT PRESENCE

Personnel, housing, dependent, medical, or other records may establish presence and duration.

DIRECT

OTHER CONDITIONS

Conditions outside the list may still be pursued with direct exposure and nexus evidence.

Apply the exact current law to the individual record. Exposure, screening, health-care eligibility, and disability compensation are related but distinct.
