FIELD REFERENCE

FOUR POINTS TO UNDERSTAND

1

IS THE CONDITION LISTED?

Use the exact regulatory diagnosis or cancer category, not a loose similarity.

2

DO THE SERVICE FACTS MATCH?

Check the named place, date range, duty, and any minimum-service rule.

3

DO OTHER REQUIREMENTS APPLY?

Some presumptions include manifestation periods, severity rules, or exclusions.

4

IF NO, TEST THE DIRECT PATH

Missing a presumption does not end the claim. Develop exposure and nexus evidence.

Apply the exact current law to the individual record. Exposure, screening, health-care eligibility, and disability compensation are related but distinct.
