

FULL NETWORK VS CONDITION-PAGE GRAPH



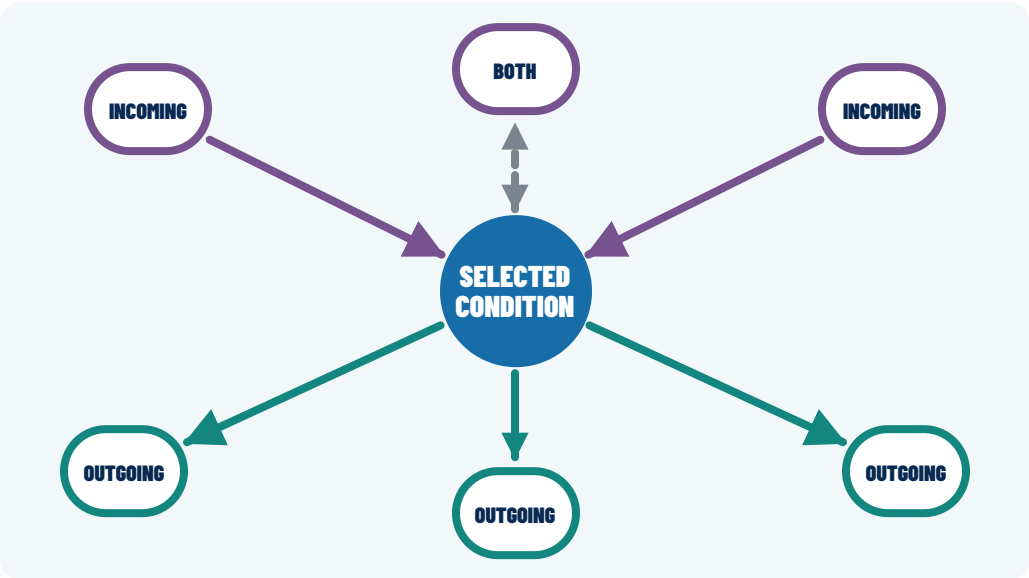
CHOOSE A VIEW

Two views of the same evidence system. Use each for a different job.

The full finder explores relationships in both directions across the network. A diagnostic-code page starts from one condition and shows conditions claimed secondary to it.

EXPLORATION TOOL

FULL SECONDARY CONDITIONS FINDER

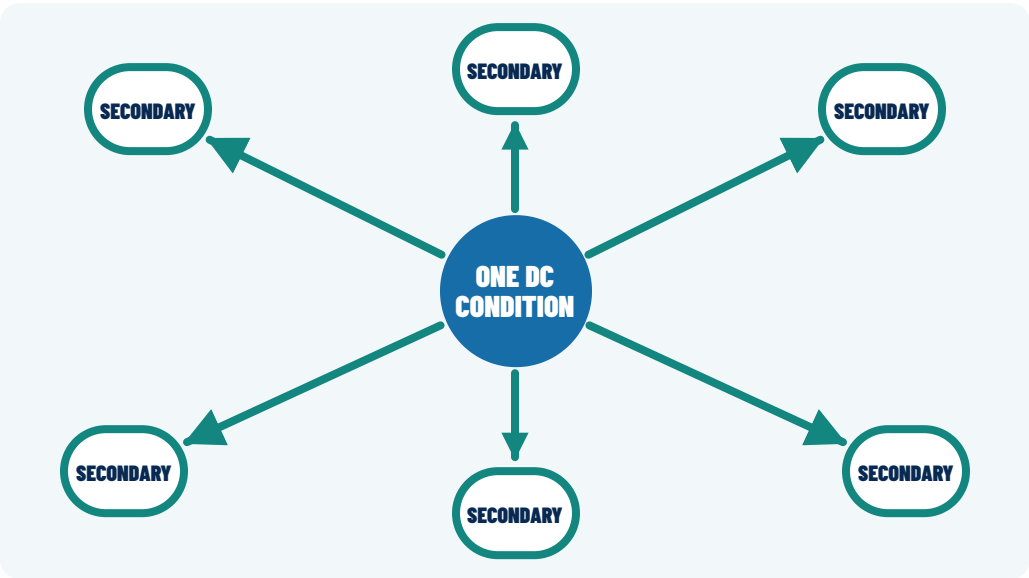


BEST FOR

- Comparing incoming and outgoing directions
- Searching the full condition network
- Filtering by volume and body system
- Exploring causation chains and related conditions

FOCUSED CONDITION TOOL

DIAGNOSTIC-CODE PAGE GRAPH



BEST FOR

- Starting from the condition you are already reading about
- Viewing conditions claimed secondary to that code
- Checking appeal volume, grant rate, and mechanisms
- Moving from a guide directly into focused research

NEED BOTH DIRECTIONS?

Use the full finder. The focused code graph is intentionally outgoing only.

NEED EXACT DETAILS?

Switch to list view for complete condition names, appeal counts, and caused or aggravated grant counts.

NEED CLAIM EVIDENCE?

Leave the graph and develop the diagnosis, primary status, medical theory, nexus, and individual chronology.

EXPLORE BROADLY. FILE PRECISELY. The network can reveal possible pathways, but each claimed link needs its own direction, theory, and supporting evidence.
