WHEN MULTIPLE DISABILITIES COUNT AS ONE

For the 60 percent or 40 percent threshold calculation, 4.16(a) treats certain groups as one disability.

REGULATORY GROUPINGS

CHECK ALL FIVE CATEGORIES

A

EXTREMITIES
Disabilities of one or both upper extremities, or one or both lower extremities, including the bilateral factor when applicable.

B

COMMON ORIGIN
Disabilities resulting from a common etiology or a single accident.

C

ONE BODY SYSTEM
Disabilities affecting a single body system, such as orthopedic, digestive, respiratory, cardiovascular-renal, or neuropsychiatric.

D

INCURRED IN ACTION
Multiple injuries incurred in action.

E

FORMER POW
Multiple disabilities incurred as a prisoner of war.
